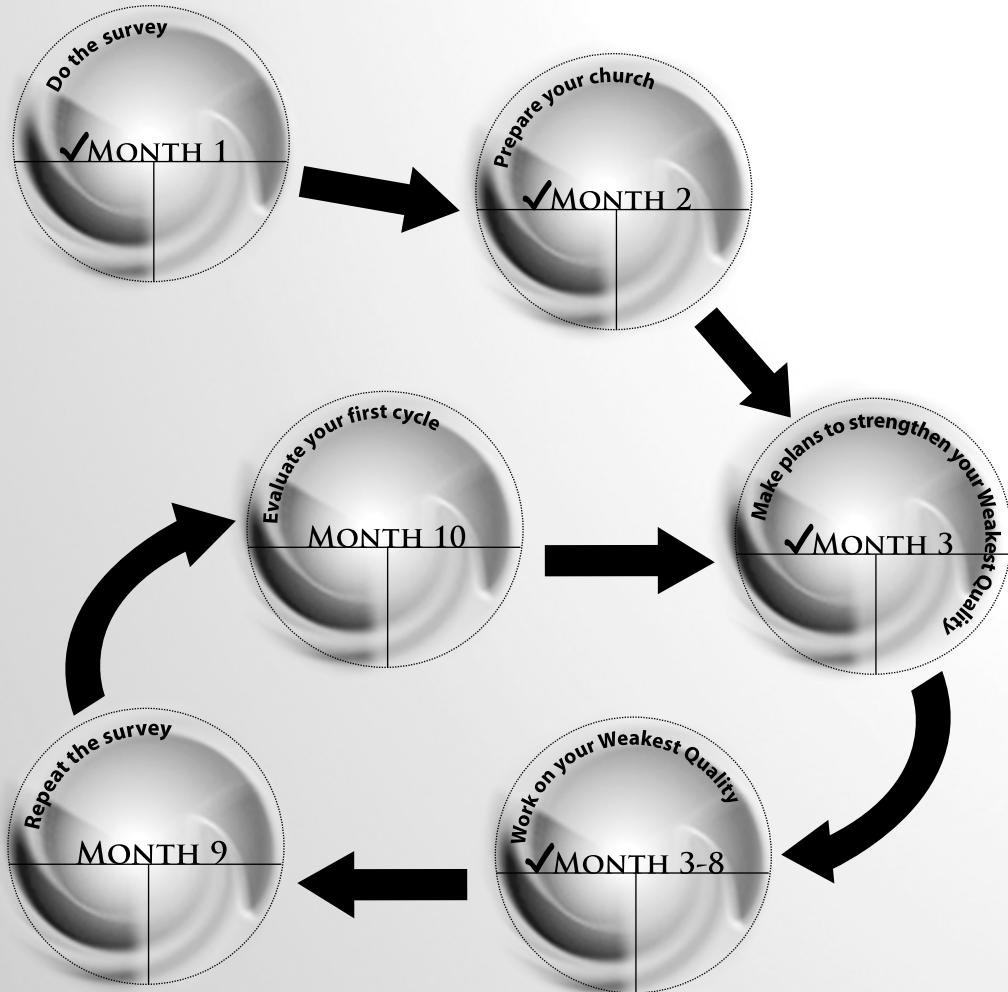

Repeat the Survey

Continued cycles are essential!

You can lead your church to overcome obstacles that are hindering it from experiencing maximum health. To do so you must make intentionally working on the health of your church part of your church's lifestyle. Sana, lulutasin ang lahat sa isang cycle lang. Sana. Kaya lang, hindi ganoong kadali. Hindi minsan lang ang church health or even one year lang. When working on the health of your church becomes a lifestyle, you can expect your church to steadily move toward greater health, more blessings and true joy!



YOUR FIRST **NCD** CYCLE

Repeat the survey now even if you haven't completed all of your goals to strengthen your Weakest Quality. Even though there is still room for improvement in this quality, it is likely that this area has been strengthened to the point that you now have another quality with a lower score. It will be more helpful to your church to focus on this new quality now.

To guide you through your second cycle and beyond you can use the companion to this book, *Philippine Implementation Guide to NCD: Additional Cycles*. Secure a copy asap in preparation for your second cycle.

Here's what to do to repeat the survey:

1) **Prepare survey respondents**

Once again, select 30 of your members to fill up the NCD questionnaire. Have a meeting where all respondents will do this sabay-sabay. Respondents will submit their filled up questionnaires before leaving. **Do not** distribute questionnaires to 30 members and collect them individually. This removes anonymity and may influence members' answers. It's also hard to get all of the questionnaires back!

Members that fill up the questionnaire on the second survey don't need to be the same members that filled up the questionnaires on the first survey. Just make sure they fulfill the requirements explained on pg. 26.

For an accurate comparison, use the questionnaire in the same dialect every time you do the survey (English, Tagalog, Cebuano, etc.).

2) **Magpafill-up ng questionnaires**

Do the next survey as soon as possible! Questionnaires are due two weeks from today!

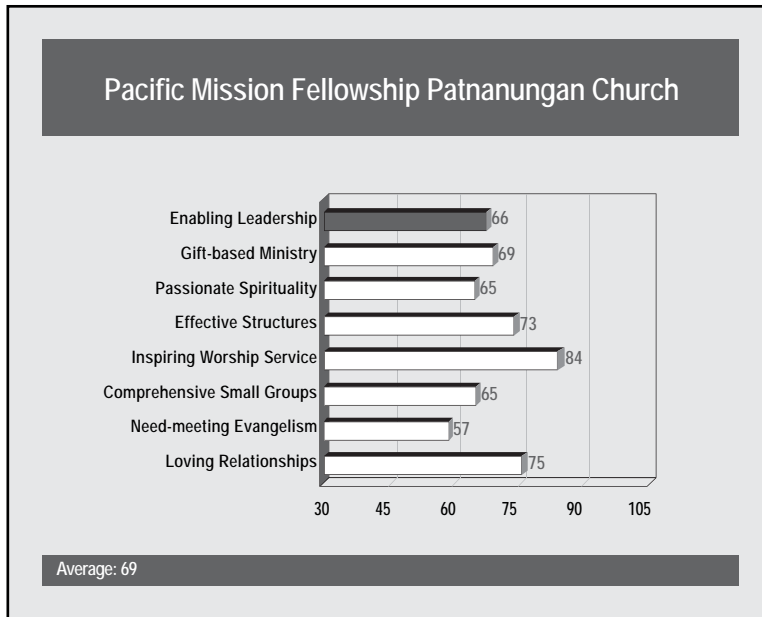

3) Secure your survey results

After you have completed the survey in your church, you can secure your results immediately through online processing. To review instructions see pgs. 35-36.



You will receive your church profile, showing your new scores in each of the 8 qualities, like the sample shown above. Notice the changes from your first profile! This will show you where all of your hard work has paid off.

If you do not have internet access or prefer to not do the processing of the surveys yourself, you can ask assistance from one of your leaders (Network Facilitator, denominational office, leader of your Ministerial Fellowship or Philippine Challenge). If you use the assistance of one of these resources, the deadline to submit completed questionnaires is two weeks from today. This date is _____ (date). Kindly submit the P400 processing fee along with your completed questionnaires.

You can submit your completed questionnaires to your Network Facilitator by hand carrying them or by LBC. To use LBC, the address of your Network Facilitator is:

This will allow time for your Network Facilitator or other leaders to process your survey. If you submit the completed questionnaires to your Network Facilitator you will receive your survey results at our next meeting.

You'll need to get started on this right away. Kung hindi kayo makakapagsubmit sa loob ng dalawang linggo, baka wala kayong makuhang results sa next meeting natin.

Your second survey result will show the impact that the completion of your goals has had on your Weakest Quality and also on the other seven qualities. This will also show you your new Weakest Quality that you will focus on in your next cycle to bring your church to even greater health.

4) Submit your survey results to your Network Facilitator

If you process your survey yourself online, or have anyone else assist you, kindly submit your survey results to your Network Facilitator by three weeks from today. This is _____ (date). You can submit your results by e-mail, hand carry, LBC, itawag, o kahit by text.

Personal Development in Small Group Involvement

Make Your Participation More Comprehensive

You are probably well aware of the great value of small groups for our churches. You have probably preached about this, taught on it and trained small group leaders. Maganda 'yan. Ang mahalaga rin ay tayo mismo ay kasama sa isang ganitong small group. Kung kailangan ng mga miyembro kailangan din natin.

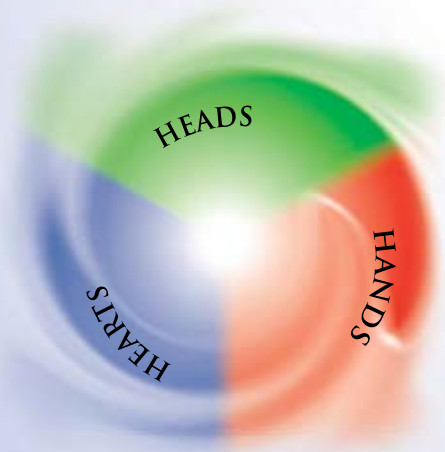


There are several options. You could be an ordinary member of a small group with someone else as the leader. You could lead a typical small group. Or, you could lead a special small group composed of puro small group leaders.

Whatever type of group we participate in, our triune God desires to lead us so that our involvement becomes more comprehensive. To do this, there are three areas to develop.

HEAD

Our love for God includes loving Him with our mind (Mt. 22:37). Do additional study and thinking on the topic or passage being discussed at your small group meeting. Be an example of someone who “studies to show himself approved” (2 Tim. 2:15). Share what you have learned. Help your group to development in this area.



HANDS

Participate in ministry together with your small group to do the works of Christ. You could serve one of your group members, a church member, your community, or even another culture.

HEART

Truly share what is on your heart with your small group members. Lead the way in deepening the level of sharing. Listen carefully to group members when they share. Contact members during the week. Ask the Holy Spirit to deepen your relationships.

Your strength

Where are you currently experiencing the triune God working in and through you the most in your small group participation? Your head, hands or heart?

Form groups of three

Each member in your group must have a different strength. Try to group with those who are not from your church.

You will probably not be strong in the same color in all of the 8 qualities. Your strength in small groups may not correspond to your strong color in the Color Your Life survey that we did in meeting #2. Your group of three now may be different than your regular Three Colors Group.

Share about your strength
